Be welcomed into a relaxed and cheerful French Provincial interior with warm Tuscan walls, cosy bedrooms, three fireplaces, French doors, a contemporary kitchen and dining area, spacious bathroom and laundry with large storage cupboards all finished with quality fittings throughout.

This restoration was well thoughtout and carefully planned with proper ventilation and treated materials used. Large verandahs surround the cottage and meet at the alfresco / carport area depending on your requirements. The grounds are simple and groomed or are ready for further garden design. Breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains and countryside truly capture the heart of this prime setting. Dual heating and cooling and grey water systems are among some the modern features. The property also includes a 25,000 gallon water tank, old dairy shed and has the potential for more water catchments and fenced areas secure for animals.
